

### Attendance Policy

-Students are allotted 5 days of excused absences without a doctor's note in one school year.

-After 5 days of excused absences a doctor's note is needed. Otherwise absences will be considered "unexcused".

-If a student tests positive for COVID proof is needed. For example: a note sent from a doctor OR a picture of the COVID test to include student's name and date.

-If proof of COVID is presented to the office, the absences due to COVID will not count toward a student's 5 days.

-Please call in your student's absence to the school office by 9am the day that they will be out. There is voicemail so that you can call any time day or night.

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# <u>Nurse's Corner</u>



Welcome...I am very excited to be starting a new school year at Croghan! For new students and families, my name is Mrs. Amor. I absolutely enjoy being a school nurse and it's a privilege to care for your children. My main priority is your child's safety and well-being during school hours. I know we are going through some "crazy times", but we will certainly be better for it! If your child will need to keep or take medication during school hours, please make sure to have the medication form completed by your healthcare provider. Forms can be obtained in the health clinic or on-line by visiting our district website. Return that form along with your child's medication in its original container labeled with his/her name. **No medication will be given without this medication authorization form**. Please refer to the student handbook for questions.

Parents of kindergartners, **please** make sure your child's immunizations are all up-to-date. If your child is not in compliance with the law set by the state of Ohio, he/she may be exempt from school until proof of immunizations is received. Parents, your attention to this matter is appreciated so your child does not miss out!

As I mentioned earlier, please visit our district website at www.fremontschools.net. You can find the Health Services Department under the Student Services tab. There you can find the necessary forms to print off for medications along with some other helpful information. The district's School Healthy Services program supports your child's academic success by promoting health and well-being in the school setting. One way that we provide care for your child is by performing health screenings as mandated by the State of Ohio. During this school year, students in kindergarten, first, third and fifth grade will have a vision and hearing screening. A letter will be sent home if there are any findings on the screenings done at school that would cause concern or need medical follow up. **Remember**, these are just screenings and **do not** take the place of regular health checkups by your healthcare provider. If you need assistance with finding a local healthcare provider or dentist, please feel free to contact my office.

A few things I would like to address as we begin our new school year. Please ensure you update any phone number changes, medical or medication changes in Final Forms. This is greatly appreciated.

We have the Mobile Dentist coming to Croghan at the end of September. Information regarding this program will be sent home soon.

Again, I am looking forward to an exciting year working with parents, students, and staff to make our school a healthy, safe and happy place to be!


