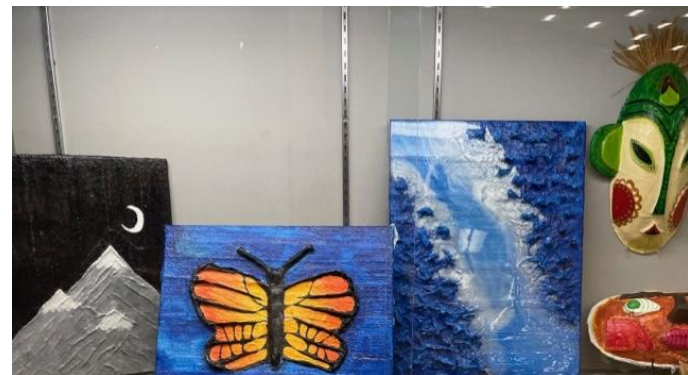

ATTENTION - Immunization Requirement for 12th Grade

Parents and Guardians of Juniors –

Ohio law requires students entering 12th grade be vaccinated against meningococcal disease. The students are required to have the MCV4 immunization prior to the first day of 12th grade.

Please contact the Sandusky County Health Department at 419-334-6367 or your family physician to schedule an appointment.

Students not in compliance with the immunization requirements are to be excluded from school attendance no later than the 15th day of the school year.

Please provide documentation to the nurse as soon as possible after your student receives the required immunization.
